

DEPOSITING

MATERIALS ON A STREET

- Defined**
- Any building material or temporary structure located within the road reserve or street, including a gantry, scaffolding or hoarding.
- Approvals**
- **Hoarding licence** - required for the deposit of any building materials on a street, road reserve or other public place - applicants must submit :
 - a site plan showing the location of the proposed materials.
 - Construction detail showing applicable heights, material sizes, spans, footing and connection details.
 - Lighting detail for covered pedestrian access ways or footpaths
 - Plans are to be submitted in duplicate together with a completed application form.
- Fees**
- \$1.00 per month for each m² of the street enclosed or used
- Notes**
- Lodge applications at the City's Technical Services counter located on the 2nd floor in the Town Hall Centre.
 - All scaffolding, gantries and working platforms must be designed and constructed in accordance with Work Safe standards
