

Strata information

Information on the following can be found on the [Western Australian Planning Commission](#) website.

The following forms are only those which the City of Fremantle has some involvement with. There are many other forms relevant to Strata Titles but these don't involve the City. The City isn't the key authority involved in Strata Titles but has a role to ensure that the buildings meet minimum Planning and Building standards.

The forms are all made under the provisions of the Strata title General Regulations 1996.

Form 24 and form 26

A Form 24 is the application form for a certificate of approval for a strata plan, re-subdivision or consolidation

Please note that this application form is now submitted to the City of Fremantle. The Western Australian Planning Commission has delegated its authority to the City to sign the Form 26 on its behalf.

The Form 26 is the Certificate of Grant of Approval by Western Australian Planning Commission to a Strata Plan. A Form 26 is issued once the City processes the Form 24 Application.

Form 7

A Form 7 is a Certificate of Local Government.

This form is prepared by the Land Surveyor who sends it to the City of Fremantle. Once the building section has inspected the building the Form 7 is completed and signed by the Principal Building Surveyor and returned to the Land Surveyor.
