White Gum Valley 6162

White Gum Valley is bounded by the Fremantle Golf Course and Stevens Street to the north, Edmun Street to the west, South Street to the south and Carrington Road to the east. White Gum Valley is located behind the ridge that lies east of Fremantle

White Gum Valley was first settled after 1890 in what has been identified as Phase Four of the development of Fremantle. Essentially, an eastern push of the locality of Beaconsfield, this settlement was facilitated in part by the provision of a tram line from the foot of High Street through to Beaconsfield and South Fremantle.

The area grew significantly in the inter-war years with a State Housing Commission residential development. Initially characterised by a mix of rural (farms, vineyards, stables, sale yards), industrial (quarry) and residential, White Gum Valley is now predominantly residential. The area has a southern retail edge along South Street, a northern parkland edge formed by the Royal Fremantle Golf Club and the newly designed and implemented Booyeembara Park.
