High Street Mall upgrade continues

Visitors to Freo's High Street Mall will soon be able to enjoy new public seating and tables, bike parking facilities and enhanced lighting as part of the City's \$275k upgrade of the mall's public realm.

The upgrades, scheduled to be completed by the end of 2015, also include replacing the existing drinking water fountain and the installation of new modern waste and recycling bins.

A new interactive public artwork is also due to be delivered later in 2016 in partnership with the owner of the Atwell Arcade.
