Appointments are for a four-year term commencing July 2026. Members will receive sitting fees of \$250 per hour.

Selection will be based on qualifications and demonstrated experience in the design and or design review of significant development proposals, in accordance with the *Design Principles of State Planning Policy 7: Design of the Built Environment*.

The City is seeking expertise in one or more of the following areas

- Heritage and urban conservation
- Energy efficient building design and sustainable development
- Public space planning and development
