REPEALED LOCAL LAWS

In accordance with sections 3.12 and 3.16 of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Fremantle gives public notice that:

1. The City of Fremantle completed a review of the Short Stay Accommodation Local Law 2008 and Local Government Model By-laws (Signs, Hoardings and Billposting) No.13 and determined that they were to be repealed.
2. The City of Fremantle adopted the City of Fremantle Short Stay Accommodation Repeal Local Law 2025.

The purpose and effect of this local law are:

Purpose: To repeal the City of Fremantle Short Stay Accommodation Local Law 2008.

Effect: To repeal an obsolete local law within the City of Fremantle.

3. The City of Fremantle adopted the City of Fremantle Local Government Model By-laws (Signs, Hoardings and Billposting), No. 13 Repeal Local Law 2025.

The purpose and effect of this local law are:

Effect: To repeal an obsolete local law within the City of Fremantle.

The repeal local laws were published in the *Government Gazette* on 2 April 2026 and will come into operation on 16 April 2026.
