Regulation requirements	If the nominees are no longer eligible to be nominated (for example, they are no longer working at the relevant business), regulation 11B of the <i>Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997</i> states the requirements to withdraw the claim. Nominees by a group of owners: A withdrawal notice must be signed by all or a majority of the people who own or occupy the rateable property, or portion of rateable property, to which the nomination relates. Nominees of a Body Corporate: A withdrawal notice must be signed by an officer of the body corporate. An Officer, in relation to a body corporate, is a director of the body corporate or other member of its governing body, the chief executive officer, or equivalent, of the body corporate, or the secretary, or equivalent, of the body corporate.
