Convened on June 18, 1904 the Tramways and Electric Lighting Board was responsible for consigning the construction and operation of the 4 public tram routes and power stations for the delivery of electricity in Fremantle. Trams ran to East and North Fremantle with a single fare costing the equivalent of 10 cents. Trams ended service in Fremantle in 1952 with the advent of bus services and the car.
