

# Compostable caddy liners



**Caddy liners supplied by the City of Fremantle are certified compostable and break down quickly during the FOGO (food and garden organic) processing.**

**They help to keep your FOGO kitchen caddy clean whilst transporting your food waste from the kitchen caddy to the FOGO bin (lime green lid) outside.**



## Replacements

Two free packs of compostable liners per financial year (one at a time) are available, upon presentation of photo identification at City facilities:

- Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19A Montreal Street Fremantle
- Fremantle Containers for Change, 83 Knutsford Street Fremantle
- Walyalup Civic Centre, 151 High Street Fremantle
- Fremantle Library, 151 High Street Fremantle

Additional liners can be purchased from the Fremantle Recycling Centre.

## Alternatives

- Go nude (and rinse in between)
- Use newspaper
- Purchase kitchen caddy liners from a shop. They must have these two logos:



## Storage

- One liner will last around 2-3 days.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from sunlight, heat, or pests.

## How to use

1

Line the caddy with your compostable liner.



2

Place all your food scraps in the caddy and other compostable material like coffee grounds.



3

After 2-3 days, or once the liner is full, place it into your FOGO bin. Food scraps can also be placed loosely in the bin.



## Tips

- Moisture and heat can cause liners to break down.
- Line the caddy liner with newspaper, paper towel or small piece of cardboard to absorb liquids.
- Cool foods before placing in caddy.
- Store caddy liners in a cool and dry location, away from direct sunlight, heat, or pests.
- Replenish your caddy liners at least annually or you may find they break down faster.
