Risk Management Plan Approval Process for Licenced Premises Under the Liquor Act

Policy scope

This policy outlines the pre-requisites when considering Risk Management Plans submitted in accordance with the requirements of the *Health (Public Buildings) Regulations 1992*.

The objective of this policy is to place responsibility on the applicant to ensure that the Risk Management Plan complies with the requirements of:

- Fremantle Police
- Department of Fire and Emergency Services
- Director of Liquor Licensing
- Department of Health
- Department of Water and Environmental Regulations
- Applicant's insurers (in respect to the property concerned)
- Australian Standard *AS/NZS ISO 31000:2009*
- Owner of the property

Policy statement

An applicant who wishes to apply under clause 9 of the *Health (Public Buildings) Regulations 1992* for an increase in patron numbers at licensed premises is to provide, with the application, signed unconditional acceptance of the Risk Management Plan from the Executive Officer all of the following:

- Fremantle Police
- Department of Fire and Emergency Services
- Director of Liquor Licensing
- Department of Health
- Department of Water and Environmental Regulations
- Applicant's insurers (in respect to the property concerned)
- Owner of the property

In addition, the Risk Management Plan will be prepared by a person or company who has good working knowledge of Australian Standard *AS/NZS ISO 31000:2009* and that person or company certifies that the Risk Management Plan presented conforms unconditionally with the requirements of *AS/NZS ISO 31000:2009*.
