SPT1802 -1 KINGS SQUARE PROJECT - PUBLIC REALM CONCEPT DESIGN

Amendment to part 4 of the committee recommendation, to read as follows:

4. *Approves the concept of integrating pre-European cultural interpretation into the Kings Square public realm, including plants and Balga trees. Concept design and will seek advice from the South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council regarding an agreed process and appropriate Noongar Whadjuk representation to develop a culturally appropriate response to place.*

REASON/S FOR CHANGE

The current concept is based on the European Square concept. To restrict the new Kings Square to being European in design is a vision based on Colonial values. Fremantle has demonstrated it is very aware of not only its Colonial past but also is committed to acknowledging and celebrating its Indigenous cultural heritage. Representation of this in the natural form would be an appropriate gesture for that commitment. Including an indigenous garden in the Kings Square project would make all people feel welcome in our new civic square.

FPOL1802-11 ADOPTION OF MEETING PROCEDURES POLICY 2018

Amendment to part 9.7 of the meeting procedures policy (as shown in red italics), to read as follows:

9.7 Notice of amendments

Elected members must give the CEO notice of all amendments and alternatives, other than those considered to be a minor amendment.

- (1) Written notice must be provided to the CEO for any proposed amendments or alternative motion (subject to clause 9.10) to substantive motion by 9 am on the morning preceding the meeting; and
- (2) All notices of proposed amendment or alternative motion must be distributed by the CEO to all elected members, ***and published on the council website*** by 12 noon on the day preceding the meeting; and
- (3) ***Any proposed amendments or alternative motion that relate to matters which, in the opinion of the CEO, is or is likely to be closed to members of the public in accordance with S 5.23 (2) of the Act, will not be published on the council website; and***
- (4) The CEO is to make reasonable attempts to notify any interested persons related to the matter.

REASON/S FOR CHANGE

To ensure that any proposed changes, are made available to the public prior to the meeting, excluding any changes relating to confidential matters.
