Proposed amendment submitted by Cr Rachel Pemberton

Add part 3 to read as follows:

3. Requests officers to find additional potential road names after local women for inclusion on the Road Names Register.

Reason: there is currently only one women's name on the City's approved Road Name Register, despite significant ongoing effort and requests to ensure women are better represented in local history interpretation signage and memorabilia including statues, place or road names.

FPOL2204-5 MANAGEMENT ORDER - PIONEER PARK RESERVE NO. 35677

Alternative recommendation submitted by Cr Marija Vujcic

Moved Cr Vujcic

Council reject the proposed Management Order for Reserve No.35677 (Pioneer Park) by the City of Fremantle as;

- a. The bore and associated infrastructure has failed and requires replacement. And,
- b. The Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage have declined a contribution towards the repair of the bore.

Reason: The State Government revoked Pioneer Park in January 2021 without the agreement of the City of Fremantle. The City of Fremantle have accepted that the State Government has now taken responsibility of Pioneer Park. It is in the best interests of the ratepayers and residents of the City that the State Government continues to be responsible for Pioneer Park.

The City of Fremantle does not accept the restoration of the management order because the State Government is now responsible for this asset.
