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**FPOL2204-3 ADVERTISING OF THE PROPOSED DIFFERENTIAL
RATE FOR THE 2022/23 FINANCIAL YEAR**

Proposed amendment submitted by Cr Rachel Pemberton

Add new part 2 to read as follows:

- 2. That Council is no longer imposing the CBD differential rate to cover the cost of the Destination Marketing program. Instead, this cost will be spread across the whole city, in recognition that the whole city benefits from Destination Marketing activities.**

Part 2 becomes 3.

Reason: To clarify the Council's position regarding the CBD differential rate.



FPOL2204-6 REVIEW OF ELECTED MEMBER RELATED POLICY

To include an additional point to the principles section of the proposed Council Code of Conduct Divisions 3 Complaint Handling Policy.

- 2. Adopt the proposed Council Code of Conduct Division 3 Complaint Handling Policy (to replace the current policy) (Attachment 1) with the following additional point included in the principles section of the policy:**

"e. Timeliness

To support both the Complainant and Respondent, complaints will be acknowledged in a timely manner, addressed promptly and according to order that they are received.

The City will take all reasonable steps to determine the outcome of a complaint within 12 weeks of receipt, and both the Complainant and Respondent will be kept informed throughout the process."

Reason: For complaints to be addressed in a timely manner as at present there is no timeline for dealing with complaints.
