244	<b>4 Free use</b>	
245	4.1 All uses for activities or events organised directly by City staff shall be supplied to the user free of charge. Bonds and cleaning charges are not be required to be paid, unless additional cleaning is required or the risk of damage is assessed as high.	
246	4.2 Any associated equipment that is required to be hired for the event to be supplied to the user at the rate specified in the City's fees and charges schedule or as per quoted hire rates. Internal business units are therefore required to provide an account number upon booking the facilities if additional equipment is required.	
247	4.3 Bookings for the Fremantle Festival are to be provided with 100 per cent off the hire fee only. Bonds, booking fee, cleaning charges, insurance costs and equipment that the City is required to hire, or is contracted to be provided, for the use being charged at full rate specified in the City's fees and charges schedule or at the quoted hire fees if provided by an external provider.	
248	4.4 The City retains the discretion to grant a subsidy of up to 100 per cent of the hire fee only to locally based community groups and schools when the following conditions are met:	
249	4.4.1 If the booking is to be held on a Monday to Wednesday which would not ordinarily be booked and would not interfere with other major or long term bookings or fully paid events	
250	4.4.2 The organiser has investigated all other opportunities to raise funds or obtain donations towards the event.	
251	4.4.3 The organiser has investigated all other possible venues in which to hold the event at a lesser cost or for free.	
252	4.4.4 The organiser can show credible proof that the number of persons attending warrants the use of the Fremantle Town Hall and not a smaller facility.
