

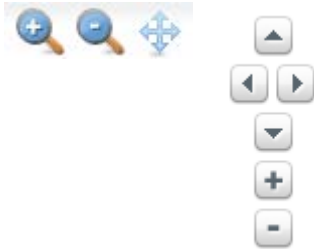
How to use IntraMaps

Navigation tools

Use these tools to navigate around the map window



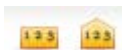
Selection tools

Use these tools to select and display information on the map



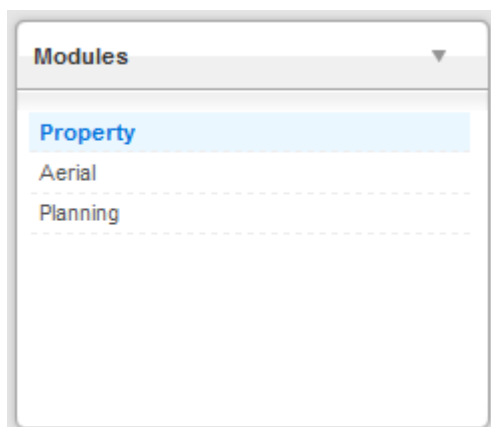
Measurement tools

Use these tools to measure distance and area. To use, click on the start of the feature you want to measure and double click at the end. Your measurement will be displayed in the results box. Please note these measurements are approximate and should not be used as a substitution for a proper survey.



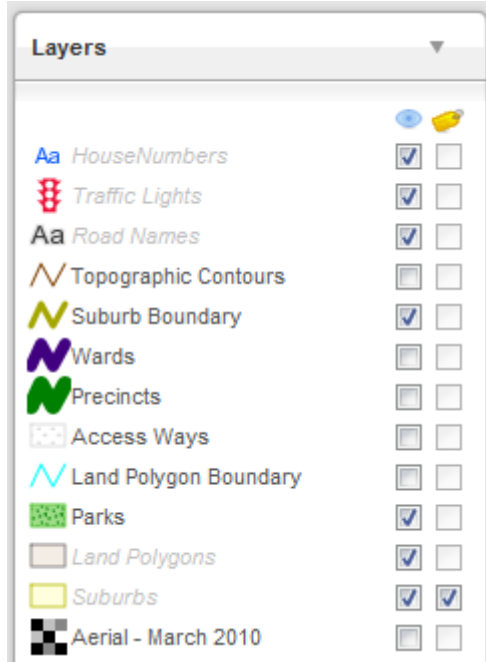
Modules

The modules box contains the various modules that exist within IntraMaps. Each module consist of feature datasets or layers, for example, aerial photographs, point or line files that represent spatial objects and contain corporate information. Modules exist to group this spatial into like datasets for ease of use and organisation.



Layers

The layers list shows the various types of information that exist within each module. The layers can be turned on and off and can also be labelled from within the layers List.



Searches

Use the search box to find information about a particular property or piece of land. Simply enter the details in the appropriate boxes and click 'search'.
