## Residents' free parking permit made simpler

Residents can look forward to simpler conditions for their free parking permit.

Effective Tuesday 1 August 2017, new conditions will allow City of Fremantle residents to park for free at all standard on-street (kerbside) car parking bays during the following times (including public holidays):

- Valid Monday-Sunday (seven days per week):
  - free parking from 9.00–11.00 am. Permit holders must abide by the posted time limits (e.g. 30 minutes, 1 hour, 2 hours).
  - free parking from 3.00–5.00 pm. Permit holders must abide by the posted time limits (e.g. 30 minutes, 1 hour, 2 hours).
  - free parking from 5.00pm – 1.00am. Time restrictions do not apply.

## Step closer for new residential verge services

A wider range of residential verge services has taken a step forward following council's adoption of the principles to a new verge policy. The policy guides the requirements from residents on how to develop and maintain their verges as well as outline new and/or expanded verge services provided by the City.

The services include the preparation of soil levels and mulch delivery for successful residential applicants to convert their verges to a garden. ## City takes action on speed humps

We've taken action to address concerns by modifying speed humps on three key Fremantle roads.

Following public feedback regarding the recent installation of speed humps along Ord Street, Wray Avenue and South Terrace, we've reduced the severity of traffic treatments but remain committed to driving behavioural change and improving safety. The changes include:

### Ord Street

Two of five speed humps have been removed and the gradient of the remaining speed humps has been softened.

### Wray Avenue

Two of four speed humps have been removed and the gradient of the remaining speed humps has been softened.

### South Terrace

Five of 15 speed humps have been removed as well as the introduction of a central speed hump to prevent cars from weaving to avoid the humps.

The City will continue to advocate to Main Roads (who control speed signs in WA) for an official speed reduction on South Terrace.
