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FPOL2112-3 GILBERT FRASER RESERVE SCOREBOARD

<u>Alternative recommendation submitted by Cr Rachel Pemberton</u>

That Council:

Refuse the application due to LPP2.14 states that "Advertisements in the form of an Animated signs will not be supported by Council."

Reason for alternative:

Notwithstanding the land is not under the management of the City of Fremantle Planning policies, the proposed sign and the uses mentioned in the report, do not comply with the City's signage policy (LPP2.14) or its intent.

LPP2.14 defines an 'Animated sign' as — "includes but not limited to any sign or its contents that moves, and includes flashing or "chasing" lights, as well as video signs, plasma and LCD screen signs and signs which are "trivision", "variable message", "changing message" and "fibre optic" signs."



FPOL2112-3 GILBERT FRASER RESERVE SCOREBOARD

Proposed amendment submitted by Cr Rachel Pemberton

- 1. Council approve the installation of the LED scoreboard at Gilbert Fraser Reserve, North Fremantle, subject to:
 - a. Approval and any conditions from the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions.
 - b. Hours of use being limited to sporting event use, school use and other community or approved events.
 - c. The illumination of the sign shall not exceed relevant Australian Standards (including AS 4282- 2019), to the satisfaction of the City of Fremantle.
 - d. The sign cannot be used for the purposes of advertising any third party or product, except for club and event sponsors during events
- 2. Ensure that the policies and decision making relating to these types of LED signs on sporting grounds and reserves is reviewed in the new year.



C2112-1 LOCAL GOVERNMENT REFORM PROPOSALS 2021 – SUBMISSION TO DLGSC

To amend the Officers recommendation as follows;

Cost of Waste Service to be Specified on Rates Notice

45. Council does not support the cost of waste services being specified on rates notices.

Cost of Waste Service to be Specified on Rates Notice

45. Council supports the cost of waste services being specified on rates notices subject to provision being made so that the current pensioner rebate can also be applied to the waste service charge.

Reason for amendment:

- Showing waste charges as a separate cost on rates notices provides transparency of costs to residents
- Residents are able to make comparisons with other LGA's running the same services.
- Waste is a key service provided by Local Government and residents should be able to see in detail what they are paying for.
- The only reason for not supporting waste charges on rates notices is because of the pensioner rate rebate. Therefore the support in the additional recommendation is qualified.
