

Litter Free-mantle Youth Art Competition

Closing date 20 May 2025



The City of Fremantle is holding an art competition for youth to promote litter education.

Students that attend school within the City of Fremantle are invited to design an artwork that conveys litter messaging.

Digital images of the artworks are to be submitted.

Up to 15 images will be selected by representatives from Keep Australia Beautiful and the City of Fremantle.

A prize pool worth \$1000, with the major winner receiving \$500 worth of items.

The selected images will be printed as stickers (120cm x 97.5 cm) and applied to public bin surrounds located around Walyalup Koort.

These images will also be printed as posters.

Submissions will be accepted from 22 April to the 20 May 2025.

This initiative fosters our local emerging art talent and raises awareness about the social and environmental issues that litter and illegal dumping.

Artwork Brief and Selection

Produce an artwork that educates the viewer about the impacts of litter on the environment, and/or contains anti-litter messaging. Inspiration can be found at the Keep Australia Beautiful [website](#).

The artwork designs will be judged based on the following criteria:

- 1. Creativity and originality of the theme.**
- 2. Quality of artistic composition.**
- 3. Relevance to the local environment and litter issues of the area.**
- 4. Entries must not contain any branding, logos, trademarks, or offensive material.**

Intellectual property remains with the student.

Materials

All two-dimension visual mediums welcome including painting, drawing, prints and photography. The selected artworks will be printed on outdoor gloss sticker, 1200mm x 975mm.

The City of Fremantle and Keep Australia Beautiful’s logos will be overlaid to the bottom right hand corner of the images.
