Information on how the Annual General Meeting of Electors is conducted

The purpose of the Annual General Meeting of Electors (AGME) is to receive the City's Annual Report and any other general business pertaining to Council. In accordance with the *Local Government (Administration) Regulations 1996*, the Mayor is to preside at a general or special meeting of electors and shall determine the procedure to be followed, as set out below:

1. All attendees are required to complete the meeting attendance register.
2. Only electors of the City of Fremantle may speak at the meeting.
3. Online attendees are not able to participate in the meeting.
4. During Public Question Time, questions or statements will be accepted at the discretion of the Presiding Person.
5. Questions should be submitted to the City by:
 - a. handing the questions in writing to the City or emailing the questions to agendasminutes@fremantle.wa.gov.au, for the attention of the Mayor before 1pm the day of the meeting.
 - b. completing and submitting a questions form immediately prior to the meeting.
6. Each elector may speak for 3 minutes during public question time, unless otherwise determined by the Presiding Person. Electors are permitted to speak again for each motion raised, but only if it is related to the motion being debated.
7. Motions, where presented in writing, will be read aloud by the Presiding Person and displayed on the screen to ensure that everyone is clear about what they are voting on.
8. Motions not presented in writing will only be accepted at the discretion of the Presiding Person.
9. Motions must clearly identify the mover and may be submitted to the City by:
 - a. handing the motion in writing to the City or emailing the motion to agendasminutes@fremantle.wa.gov.au for the attention of the Mayor before 1pm the day of the meeting.
 - b. completing and submitting a motions form immediately prior to the meeting.

10. The Presiding Person will call for a mover and a seconder for a motion.
11. Upon a motion being moved and seconded, the Presiding Person will call for speakers to the motion.
12. When addressing the meeting a person is requested to:
 - a. state their full name and suburb.
 - b. address the meeting in a non-offensive manner.
13. Any number of amendments may be moved and seconded on each motion, however only one amendment on any one motion will be dealt with at a time. Each amendment will be dealt with before any further amendment can be received.
14. The Presiding Person will read aloud the motion, as amended and then call for a vote on that motion.
15. Each elector is entitled to vote on each motion.
16. Voting is determined by a show of hands, and a simple majority carries the vote, as determined by the Presiding Person.
17. Attendees who are not an elector of the City of Fremantle may not ask a question, raise a motion, speak to a motion, or vote.
18. Minutes of the meeting will be available for inspection by members of the public within 10 days after the meeting is held.
19. Minutes will only record a summary of the meeting and not a verbatim account.
20. Any motions arising from the meeting requiring action will be further considered by Council at the next appropriate Ordinary Council Meeting.
21. The proceedings are recorded for the purpose of producing the minutes and speakers are requested to use the microphones each time they speak. No other audio or visual recording is to be undertaken without the permission of the Presiding Person.
