**Proposed Amendment by Cr Jemima Williamson-Wong**

To amend the Officer's Recommendation, to read as follows:

**Council:**

- 1. Receive the Community Engagement Report, provided in Attachment 1;**
- 2. Endorse the draft Community Safety Crime Prevention Plan 2026 2031, as provided in Attachment 2, for the purpose of advertising for community consultation *with the following amendments:***
  - a. specify that the Community Safety Reference Group will meet four times a year;***
  - b. remove 'donate without a doubt' initiative; and***
- 3. Note that the Community Safety Crime Prevention Plan 2026-2031, will be brought back to Council for final consideration.**

**Reasons for amendment:**

To clarify the expectations of the Community Safety Reference Group and update the action plan to reflect that the current donate without a doubt initiative has not gathered any donations.

  - a. Lighting as a priority deliverable;**
  - b. Consideration of CCTV rebates; and**

**Reasons for amendment:**

The lack of adequate lighting at night was the number one factor identified making people feel less safe in our community.

CCTV rebates would support people who want to install CCTV cameras because they are feeling unsafe or are having issues that could be addressed with CCTV.

  - a. "Investigate the feasibility, and advocate for, the implementation of a supervised drug use facility in Fremantle"; and**
- 4. Note that the Community Health and Wellbeing Plan 2026-2031 will be brought back to Council for final consideration.**

**Reasons for amendment:**

Visible drug use continues to be an issue in Fremantle, with many people reporting this as a priority issue throughout the community engagement. Supervised drug use facilities assist in reducing visible drug use, decreasing the strain on emergency services, preventing overdose deaths and helping to connect drug users with rehabilitation programs and education. While the current State Government have indicated they do not support a facility in WA, this should not stop the City of Fremantle investigating the feasibility and advocating for support to help manage the ongoing drug use within Fremantle.

  - a. Add the following action to Priority Area 1 – Create a sense of belonging for all members of the community: *"Support for Farmers' Market in North Freo and Samson"***
  - b. Amend Priority Area 3 – Address homelessness and housing access to read as follows: *"Continue to investigate sites and opportunities for crisis accommodation and supported housing options in Fremantle"***
  - c. Amend Priority Area 3 – Address homelessness and housing access to read as follows: *"Advocate for the development of affordable rental accommodation, Community Land Trusts, Modular/Pre-fabricated homes, Small temporary grouped housing, and granny flats in central Fremantle for students, in turn creating a student collective in the City"***
  - d. Add the following action to Priority Area 4 – Ensure safe access to community and the local environment: *"Provide CCTV rebates"***
  - e. Add the following action to Priority Area 5 – Promote and provide physical activity opportunities: *"Prioritise continuous bicycle routes across our city"***
  - f. Add the following action to Priority Area 5 – Promote and provide physical activity opportunities: *"Maintain our parks and recreation areas to the high(est) standards"; and***
- 4. Note that the Community Health and Wellbeing Plan 2026-2031 will be brought back to Council for final consideration.**



**Reasons for amendment:**

Both of these suburbs lack a fresh food grocer and filling that gap with a temporary market would help foster a sense of community and belonging.

If we improve (or keep) the level of maintenance for these places to a high standard then more people will feel comfortable using them for physical activities.

**Council:**

- 2. Endorse the draft Community Health and Wellbeing Plan 2026-2031, as provided in Attachment 2, for the purpose of advertising for community consultation;**
- 3. Request the following matters be considered as potential actions within the plan:**
  - a. The need to review and enforce rules relating to smoking and vaping in public places, especially in alfresco areas, so as to strengthen requirements relating to policing of the rules and to remove any confusion about how the rules apply to liquor licensed areas.**
  - b. Societal and mental health problems related to gambling in the Health Plan, including in relation to restrictions on gambling advertising of events and sports.**
  - c. Review whether accommodating private vehicles (cars, bikes etc.) in the city centre is necessarily mutually exclusive to the establishment of pedestrian friendly space and review the extent to which the use of sustainable forms of personal transport provides better access to healthy activities for people living in areas not well served by public transport**
  - d. Greater reference to the need to establish green corridors to provide residents with improved access to regionally significant open space, coastal areas and bushland.**
  - e. Recognise the opportunity to provide significant upfront assistance to get new community gardens and verge planting groups established and supported; and**
- 4. Note that the Community Health and Wellbeing Plan 2026-2031 will be brought back to Council for final consideration.**

**Reasons for amendment:**

To identify areas of the plan to be reviewed prior to presenting a final draft for approval.

There are issues with ongoing vacancy in the City of Fremantle, which could be supported by the activation of certain areas, streets and sites through the Seasonal Trading Policy. The feasibility of these sites for inclusion on the Policy should be investigated.
