



# Compostable caddy liners

Caddy liners supplied by the City of Fremantle are certified compostable and break down quickly during the FOGO (food and garden organic) processing.

They help to keep your FOGO kitchen caddy clean while transporting your food waste from the kitchen caddy to the FOGO bin (lime green lid) outside.

## Replacements

Two free packs of compostable liners per financial year (one at a time) are available, upon presentation of photo identification at City facilities:

- Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19A Montreal Street Fremantle
- Fremantle Containers for Change, 83 Knutsford Street Fremantle
- Walyalup Civic Centre (Reception Ground Level), 151 High Street Fremantle
- Fremantle Library (Lower Ground), 151 High Street Fremantle

Additional liners can be purchased from the Fremantle Recycling Centre.

## Alternatives

- Go nude (and rinse in between)
- Purchase kitchen caddy liners from a shop








# How to use your caddy liner

Line the caddy with your compostable liner

Place all food scraps and other compostable materials (like coffee grounds) in the caddy

After 2-3 days, or once full, dispose in your FOGO bin

## Tips

- One liner will last around 2-3 days and should be stored in a cool, dry place away from sunlight, heat, or pests
- Food scraps can also be placed loosely in your FOGO bin
- Moisture and heat can cause liners to break down
- Drain liquids before placing food waste into the caddy liner
- Cool foods before placing in caddy
- Store caddy liners in a cool and dry location, away from direct sunlight, heat, or pests
- Replenish your caddy liners at least annually or you may find they break down faster
