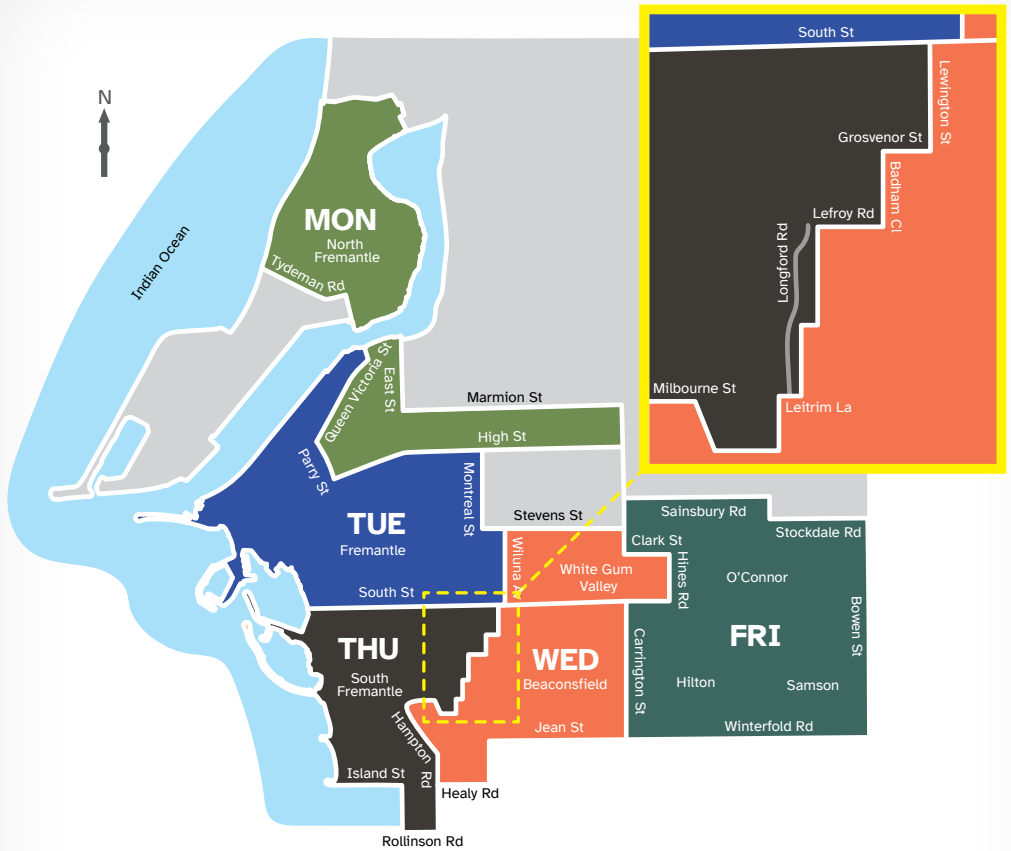

Putting your bins out for collection



Place bins on kerb by 6am on collection day



Maximum weight of each bin is 70kg



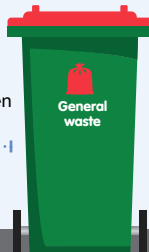
Avoid overfilling to ensure lid can close



1m from trees



0.5m between bins



1m from cars, fences, and other items



Return your bins behind your property line as soon as possible, after collection.

Your benchtop caddy makes sorting your food organics in the kitchen simple.

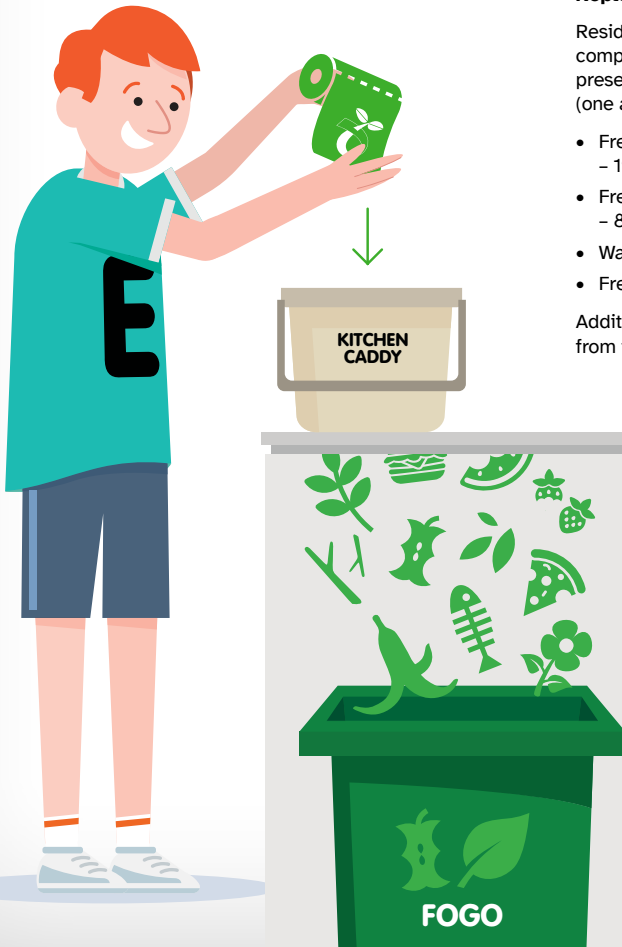

Residents are eligible for two free packs of compostable liners per financial year, upon presentation of photo ID at City facilities (one at a time):

– 19a Montreal St, Fremantle
- Fremantle Containers for Change
– 83 Knutsford St, Fremantle
- Walyalup Civic Centre – 151 High St, Fremantle
- Fremantle Library – 151 High St, Fremantle

EASY RECYCLING RULES

LOOSE

Items should always be loose. Bagged items cannot be recycled.



RINSE

Empty and rinse your recyclables to reduce contamination.



LIDS OFF

Remove lids from bottles and containers.



PAPER

Clean and not shredded



CARDBOARD

Flattened and clean



CANS AND TINS

Steel and aluminium



PLASTIC BOTTLES AND CONTAINERS

Rinsed and lids removed



GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS

Rinsed and lids removed



IMPORTANT INFORMATION



No meat trays



No soft plastics



No aerosols, gas bottles or electronic waste



No nappies



No food or garden organics



No tetra paks

Place bottle lids in your general waste bin or recycle them at the Fremantle Recycling Centre.



CHECK FOR THE 10c MARK



In WA, most beverage containers are accepted by Containers for Change, including wine and spirit bottles from 1 July 2026.

Household Hazardous Waste Facility

Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle

A limit of 20kg or 20 litres per material type.

The following waste materials are covered under the HHW Program:



- Acids
- Aerosols – CFC based
- Aerosols, flammable – paint and lacquers
- Aerosols, flammable – pesticide
- Alkali
- Arsenic based products
- Batteries – household, dry cell
- Cyanides
- Engine coolants and glycols
- Fire extinguishers – non-Halon
- Flammable liquids – hydrocarbons and fuels
- Flammable solids
- Flares
- Fluorescent tubes, CFL and light fittings
- Gas cylinders – other
- Gas cylinders – propane
- General household chemicals e.g., cleaners
- Heavy metal compounds
- Inorganic oxidising agents – e.g., pool chlorine
- Low level radioactive substances e.g., smoke detectors
- Mercury – elemental
- Organic peroxides
- Paint – metal based, other, including isocyanates and amines, recyclable, solvent based, including resins and adhesives, water based
- PCB materials
- Pesticides – non-Schedule X
- Pesticides – Schedule X
- Solvents – halogenated
- Toxics
- Unknown chemicals if they are in a secure, sealed, chemical-resistant container.

Fremantle Recycling Centre

Bulk waste entry passes are now digital for City of Fremantle residents (no commercial access). Six digital passes are allocated to each residential property from 1 July.

Upon entry present current proof of residency with photo identification is required, like a driver's license or rates notice with other photo identification eg, passport.

Accepted items:

- Aerosol cans
- Batteries (vehicle and household)
- Bread tags (plastic only)
- Can clips (Containers for Change)
- Cardboard
- Clean and unbroken blocks, bricks, and pavers
- Clean garden organics (up to 1.5m in length and 30cm in diameter, one trailer load up to 3 cubic metres per day, fees apply for additional loads)
- Clothing, shoes, and bags (good condition)
- Coffee pods
- Contact lenses and packaging including plastic film, pods and cardboard packaging (not contact lens solution bottles)
- Cooking oil (up to 20L)
- Electrical appliances and electrical cables
- Electronic waste; computers, TVs and accessories
- Mattresses and bed bases (fees apply)
- Medicinal blister packs (empty and maximum 30 per day)
- Mobile phones
- Motor oil (up to 20L)
- Plastic bottle lids
- Plastic plant pots
- Polystyrene
- Printer cartridges
- Razor blades and packaging
- Recyclables (same as your yellow-lid bin)
- Stationary (new or near new)
- Scrap metal
- Thongs (flip flops)
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes, floss packets and electric toothbrush heads
- Tyres (fees apply)
- Whitegoods
- X-rays

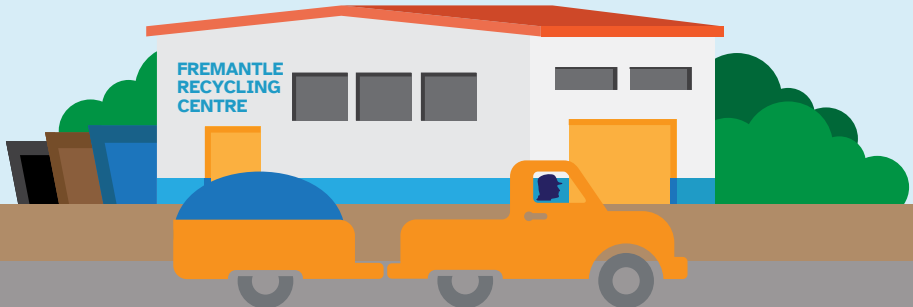

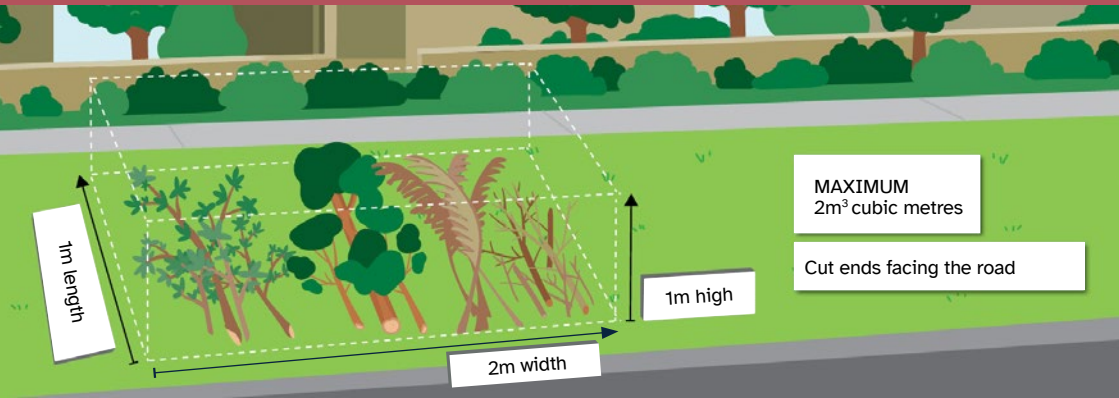

Accepted materials:

- ✓ Maximum of 2m³
- ✓ Tree trunks up to 1.5m in length and no more than 30cm in diameter
- ✓ Palm fronds
- ✓ Branches and shrub prunings

Non accepted materials:

- × Sand and or soil
- × Lawn sods
- × Coppers logs
- × Sleepers
- × Household rubbish
- × Plastic
- × Recyclables
- × Bags of grass clippings or weeds

Garden organics can be placed on verge up to 3 days prior to the collection your own start date.

Verge Valet™ is the convenient new bulk waste vergé collection for all residential properties, including apartments and CBD properties.

Each residential property is entitled to 1 free bulk waste collection per financial year.

Complexes over 25 units require the caretaker or strata manager to book collections.

How does Verge Valet™ work?

1. Get rid of the good stuff

See if you can sell, donate, repair or give away anything that's still usable before booking Verge Valet™.

2. Book your collection online

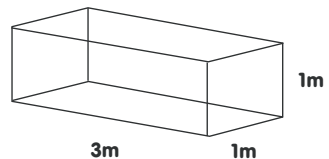
3. Place your junk on the vergé

Ensure waste is placed on your vergé no more than 3 days before your collection date. Wait for an email and/or text message confirming your collection date. Please have your junk ready by 7am.

How to set out your waste

- Put your junk on the vergé no more than 3 days before your confirmed collection.
- Please place your items into separate piles to maximise recovery and recycling.

Remember: limit of 3m³ per collection
