In accordance with section 5.28 of the *Local Government Act 1995* the City has received a written request from more than 300 electors to hold a Special Meeting of Electors.

The motion to be discussed as requested by electors is:

"That Council immediately halt all clearing and mature tree removals across the City of Fremantle, specifically including the destruction of mature trees at Hilton Reserve, and mandate that any future infrastructure, sports, or masterplan developments must be redesigned to prioritise 100% retention of mature urban canopy."

This meeting is open to all members of the public, however, only Electors of the City of Fremantle District may vote on proposed motions, make statements, or ask questions.

Due to this request, the City will now pause commencement of the works to develop the sports grounds at Hilton Park until these meetings have been held.
